

Receives national gaming license in Sweden

ENLABS AB announce that the Swedish Gaming Authority (Lotteriinspektionen) has granted the company a license for commercial online gaming and betting.

ENLABS (earlier Nordic Leisure) is therefore ready to operate in Sweden from 1st of January 2019, when the new gaming law is enforced.

ENLABS is now obtaining online gaming licenses in seven (7) countries.

"We are very happy to obtain the Swedish gaming license and can now establish ourselves on another licensed market. It's even more satisfactory to bring our many years of experience from regulated markets and now compete on our home market Sweden on regulated fair terms.
